	Start class discussion with topic of Mother's day - what sort of images do they associate with it? Explain we will be designing our own moving Mother's day cards.	Look again at some exisiting Mother's day products - what visual are commonly used, which do they think would appeal to their ow intended audience?		
	First we will explore the different mechanisms that we could use to make the moving parts - levers, sliders, hinges. Children will explore making mock-ups of each type, discussing pros and cons of each type in relation to using them in a card.	Model designing the card, with the audience in mind, emphasising the importance of neat, careful work. Label the design with the key design features.		
	Once they have decided on a type of mechanism they can draw a design in their sketchbook.	Children design their own moving card.

Lesson 3: to create a card based on their previous design.

Show children examples of cards made to follow a design, one carefully made and one not. Can they see the difference? Reinforce the idea that the process needs to be carefully done rather than rushed, to create a beautiful end product that the audience will appreciate.

In small groups children will make the cards as per their design criteria.

Lesson 4: to evaluate their finished product

Use powerpoint to work through the evaluation questions: what went well? What would we change?

Children answer the evaluation questions in their sketchbooks.
