



## Welcome to Acorns Class!

Mrs Dolding is the Nursery class teacher and is supported by Mrs Phillips and Mrs Sansom. One of the Forest School leaders, Gareth leads the children's Forest School on Monday.

Nursery runs both a morning and afternoon session: 8.45 - 11.45am and 12.30 - 3.30pm. Children can choose to attend 5 morning or 5 afternoon sessions a week. There is also an option to purchase extra sessions through the week and stay for the whole day, at a cost of £18 a session which includes a place in lunch club. You can also attend just the lunch club at a cost of £4. This cost includes a hot meal and adult supervision.

We run fun; topic based interactive sessions, which are exciting, innovative and imaginative, enabling us to learn through our play.

This terms topic is, '**Can I Have a Dog Yet?**' Please see the overview for the learning which will take place this term.

Please could you provide for your child:-

- A pair of wellie boots for use outside for wet and muddy play.
- An appropriate waterproof coat to wear on days with inclement weather.
- A named water bottle.
- A full change of clothes.
