Maths

- How far can you count?
- Can you sort your toys into different groups and then count them.
- Can you share **your** toys—with you and your teddy—how many would you have each?
- Can you measure in steps how wide your bedroom is? Kitchen? Which room is the biggest

- Share your favourite stories, Who are the characters?
- Can you find stories with different animals in them?
- Can you make up a story about an animal?
- Can you draw a picture of an animal and tell someone about it.
- Practise writing your name, families names and friends.
- Can you make a shopping list? List of jungle animals?

UW-

- What changes do you notice out of your window?Can you draw a picture?
- How tall is your sunflower—can you record how much it has grown?
- Can you sort toy animals /pictures? where they live, what colour they are, what they eat.
- Log in to Purple Mash and access different activities on the alert bar.

PSED/EAD

Can you challenge yourself to help your family in different ways.

Make sure you do something kind for someone else.

Can you help make dinner/lunch?

Can you set the table? Help wash up?

Can you make up a repeating rhythm—clap clap, nod nod, clap, clap... etc

Physical Development- Gross Motor

How many times can you bounce the ball, with one hand, two hands?

Can you throw and catch the ball?

Can you make up a dance to your favorite song?

Can you make up an obstacle course in your garden—can you go over, under, through, round objects—making sure you are safe though!

Fine motor

Cutting skills—can you make a spiral snake and cut it out?

Can you thread pasta/cheerioes onto a string to make a necklace?
