



Maths: One More or one less

Can you make an abacus using beads or pasta on string to find 1 more or 1 less practically.



Make own number line using chalk outside

Cut and stick numbers from magazines and newspaper to make number lines. Then get a grown up to ask you questions ... What is 1 more than 13? What is one more than 16? What is 1 less than 20?

Can you make number cards to 20. Turn them upside down, Choose a card then tell a grown up what number is one more or less than that card.

Play a game like snakes and ladders where you have to count on and move back.

Can you make up your own adventure story, by retelling it using your toys or by drawing a story book? Where would you go ?
