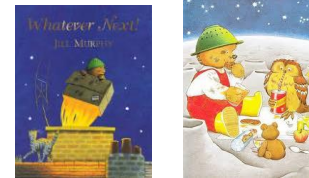
Counting objects to 20 - more and less
