Maple and Beech News (Reception)

This week in Reception, we have written our letters to Santa, hopefully you will all get a reply before Christmas. The children all were really motivated to write and everyone recorded their name, most wrote the beginning letters to the words and some even sounded out the whole word. We have noticed how the children seem much more secure with the letter sounds that they have learnt this term, well done! In maths, we have been looking carefully at coins, noticing the numbers on them and finding out which is more. They have enjoyed looking for coins in the sand and sorting them into pots.

In Outdoor learning the children are continuing to practise their skipping skills and working as a team to play parachute games. This week the children had a fire and cooked popcorn on it.

Our Christmas songs are improving with every practise and we have been performing them to one another outside on the stage.

Birch and Cherry (Year 1)

In maths this week, we have continued learning about addition and subtraction using a number line and solving word problems. In English we have continued to learn the story of Beegu. We have drawn story maps to help us rewrite the story. We have also been practising our Christmas songs and learning the Christmas story.

At the beginning of next half term we are going to be developing our mapping skills. If anyone has any interesting maps that they would be willing to donate to the school, we would be grateful. We are looking for lots of different types of maps such as maps of theme parks/zoos, maps of different countries, OS maps etc. Thank you

Hazel and Rowan News (Year 2)

This week, in writing, Year 2 have described in detail the characters and settings in a story, using exciting adjectives, expanded noun phrases, and have explored other interesting language such as similes and adverbs. Do ask your child what kinds of words these are! The children have also prepared for and independently written their own versions of a story using all the ideas and language that they have been rehearsing over the last two weeks: The Snowman in Rowan class, and The Steadfast Tin Soldier in Hazel class.

In maths, both classes have mainly been working hard on arithmetic, and reasoning and problem solving assessments, applying all that they have learnt so far this term.

The children have also been busy finishing their versions of a guitar in the style of Picasso and making Christmas cards, as well as learning more about the Beatles in History, and e-safety (why there are age restrictions for on-line games and social media).
