CURRICULUM

The school will aim to:

- Inspire curiosity for learning through a broad and balanced curriculum
- Ensure that every pupil is taught at an appropriate and challenging level by qualified teachers
- Maintain an attractive environment with good materials and equipment and teach the full National Curriculum and religious education
- Provide high quality teaching, including specialist sports and music lessons
- Ensure that all pupils participate in outdoor activities

- Ask for help with their learning

Parents/Guardians will aim to:

- Encourage my child to participate fully in school activities
- Support my child's learning at school by attending parents' meetings, performances and open afternoons

- Engage my child in regular discussions about current learning
- Ensure school property is looked after when at home.
- Read stories to and with my child frequently.

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

The school will aim to:

- Start classes promptly at 9.00am
- Maintain an accurate record of attendance
- Celebrate good attendance at the end of each term
- Liaise with parents/carers if we have concerns about attendance

Pupils will try to:

• Come to school regularly and arrive on time

Parents/Guardians will aim to:

- Make sure that my child is at school regularly, on time and prepared for learning
- Make sure that my child is collected on time
- Contact the school promptly when my child is absent

WELFARE AND COMMUNICATION

The school will aim to:

- Ensure that pupils are safe on school premises and on school trips
- Administer medicines only with written permission and according to the medicines policy
- Give full and clear information about the curriculum, and each pupil's progress, standards achieved and development needs.
- Communicate frequently with parents about school matters and set dates for events early and inform parents.

Pupils will try to:

- Tell a grown up if worried about anything at home or in school
- Follow e-safety rules when working with electronic devices at home and in school

Parents/Guardians will aim to:

- Teach my child about personal hygiene
- Make sure the school always has an up to date emergency contact number
- Keep my child at home when unwell
- Raise my concerns with the appropriate person as early as possible
- To let the school know of issues that may affect my child's welfare or progress at school
