#### **School News**

Happy New Year to you all! We hope you all had an enjoyable Christmas and were able to celebrate more than the previous year.

We have welcomed the children back this week and although it is a short week, the children have been very busy in their classrooms and were keen and eager to learn. We are looking forward to watching their development this term.

We welcome Miss Henly who joins us as class teacher in Rowan class and Miss Cullip, who joins us as an early years practitioner in our nursery.

Covid infections are proving very challenging, and we will be doing our upmost to keep classes open.

Please do let us know if close contacts test positive. Children can still come to school if they have no symptoms but should carry out LFD's daily for seven days. (I know that LFD's are in short supply, but do try throughout the day as Gov.uk are sending packs out, as are local pharmacies if you get a Gov.uk QR code).

All visitors to the school will need to LFD before arriving and wear a mask on site.

We are doing our best to keep classrooms well ventilated as well as keeping them warm. Please make sure children come into school with coats, hats and gloves (all named please!) so they can still enjoy time outside.

Children also need their navy tracksuits for outdoor PE included in their PE kits, (These are also great to have as a spare set of clothes to change into), along with trainers. Trainers or plimsolls are required for PE for health and safety reason. If children wear tights to school, please ensure they have a spare pair in their bag as well as socks for PE.

The children have all settled back into Nursery very well this week. This half term we have started a new topic, 'How many colours in the rainbow?', and we have been exploring colours in the rainbow and our favourite colours. We have been learning the song 'I can sing a rainbow', and will be making our own rainbows. Next week we will be exploring the story 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear' and learning how to mix colours to create new ones. Keep an eye on Seesaw for more resources and to see what else we are learning!

#### Maple and Beech class (Reception)

This week the children have all settled back really well into school. We have been exploring the icy weather outside, freezing characters in the ice and trying to free them, writing our names in the frost and spotting shapes in the ice.

In Literacy we have begun learning the story of, 'The Little Red Hen'. The children will be learning it off by heart. We have put a link on Seesaw, if you want to help them practice their story and actions at home.
