Little Acorns Pre-Nursery

We are delighted to have launched the Little Acorns library scheme. The children can choose from a selection of books to take home every week and share with you. It's a wonderful opportunity to encourage the development of multiple skills such as speech and language, developing literacy knowledge and helping sitting and listening skills. Please ensure that your borrowed book is returned to the nursery the first session your child attends the following week.

In the nursery this week, we have been putting our fine motor skills to the test. The children have enjoyed twisting and turning colourful screws into different shapes, drawing patterns on leaf-shaped paper and threading with wooden fruits. We have listened to a variety of music this week and thought about how we can move our bodies to the sounds we hear.

Well done, Little Acorns. What a wonderful week!

Acorns

This week in Acorns we have enjoyed reading, 'The Gruffalo' and role playing/acting out the story. Some children have also painted Gruffalo pictures on the easel.

The children have loved decorating the Nursery and the adding decorations to the tree. They have also had fun dancing to Christmas songs.

The children have been working very hard on our Christmas performance and it is really coming on nicely. They are so excited to show you what they have learned!

Maple and Beech News (Reception)

This week in Reception we have been learning the sounds th, ng and the tricky words all and they.

We have been thinking about making Christmas lists, using Argos catalogues to pick items we might like and then making our Christmas lists.

In maths we have been re-capping on all the work we have done this term.

We have been practising hard for our Christmas Nativity. We look forward to performing it for you next week.

Birch and Cherry (Year 1)

This week in Year One, we have been very busy practising our songs and actions for the 'Whoops-A-Daisy Angel' production and learning when to come on and off the stage. We look forward to a fantastic show next week.

In English, the children decided how to change the story of 'The Three Little Pigs' to make their own version of the story. Some examples included 'Three Little Rabbits', 'Three Little Deer' and 'Three Little Elk'. They used the results of our Internet search for: 'What animals do wolves eat?' to help them choose their characters. They also used their science knowledge of materials to help them pick different building materials in the story. They picked materials that would be easily blown down by the wolf for the first and second houses and then a solid material for the third house. Birch class chose a house made of leaves, followed by a house made of cloth. Cherry Class changed the brick house to one made of gold!

Our grammar focus this week was 'plurals'. We learnt that some nouns are made plural by just adding an 's', whereas others need 'es' to be added. They learnt that nouns ending in s, ch, sh, ss, x and z typically require 'es' to make them plural. We did however, begin to learn that there are some other irregular ways of making a plural and that words like 'sheep' and 'fish' do not change!

In maths this week, we were consolidating our naming and describing of 2D and 3D shapes. We then answered a few short test questions to establish our strengths and next steps for improvement. If you would like to help your child with their shape knowledge at home, there are numerous shape quizzes on PurpleMash. I have set a couple of activities as 'To do's', so when they log on to PurpleMash, they should appear as a bell at the top of the page. Please do speak to a member of the Year 1 staff if you do not have your child's log in details.

Our focus phonics sounds this week were: ar, or, ur, ow, and oi.

Hazel and Rowan (Year 2)

This week has been a very busy one for year 2. We are lucky enough this year to have been chosen to decorate a tree at the local Christmas festival. The theme for this year is 'Royalty', so year 2 have decided to honour the late Queen Elizabeth II. We have been busy creating crown decorations and writing labels including our thanks to the Queen, as well as creating a special red, white and blue wreath. Our tree will be on display at St Mary's Church the weekend of 10th and 11th December – please do pop along and see it if you can!

As well as this, we have been practising hard for our Christmas production. Our afternoons have been full of beautiful singing and rehearsing lines in preparation for our performances next week. Thank you for all the costumes that have been brought in – it is really starting to come together!

In English, the children have enjoyed writing their own story inspired by 'The Bear and the Piano'. Some of our favourite new titles have included 'The tiger and the electric guitar', 'The bunny and the harp' and 'The unicorn and the recorder'! We have been so impressed by the children's use of powerful adjectives and their attempts to include a range of conjunctions – keep it up year 2!

In maths, we have continued to learn about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We have been counting the sides and vertices of 2D shapes and beginning to sort them according to their properties. Why not try playing 'guess my shape' with your child. For example "It has 4 vertices and 4 sides that are all the same length"... any guesses?

Finally, the children have really enjoyed this term's DT project. They have used their sewing skills to create some fantastic finished products. We don't want to give too much away but save a space for something special on your Christmas tree this year!

Breakfast Bees and Bumblebees

This week in Bumblebees we have been adding the finishing touches to our Christmas cakes – they look fantastic!

The children have played Chess, made 3D paper pictures, and we have made lots and lots of paper snowflakes to decorate our room!
