Birch and Cherry (Year 1)

We have had a busy last full week in Year 1. Well done to all the children for coping so well with the heat of Sport's Day and for their positive behaviour and attitude during the events. In maths, we have had some test questions to assess our learning and to identify our strengths and weaknesses for the classes next year. Here are some examples of the questions that the children found more challenging: 10 - ? = 10? = 9 + 8A quarter of ? = 215 + 4 = 10 + ?
