Little Acorns Pre-Nursery

The festive activities have begun this week in Little Acorns, to the delight of all the children. We had a range of Christmasthemed activities such as sorting Christmas pom-poms, practicing our pencil control whilst writing a letter to Father Christmas and posting them in our post box, playing with the small world Christmas village and reading a variety of Christmas stories. This week a favourite amongst the children was 'Pip and Posy - The Christmas tree'.

During carpet time, we talked about how to keep warm in the cold weather and encouraged the children 'have a go' at putting on their coats and hat themselves.

During outdoor play, we talked about what changes we could see to our garden now the winter months are here. The children enjoyed the messy play tray of dinosaurs in the snow. The children enjoyed making footprints and marks using the feet and tails of the dinosaurs!

Acorns

The children have all worked hard this week and have learnt some Christmas songs. We are very proud of all our Acorns for their beautiful performance as 'Twinkling Stars'.

In maths, we have been focussing on recognising numbers and counting baubles as we put them on the tree.

We had our last Outdoor Learning session this week and the children were very excited when we made our own popcorn!



Maple and Beech News (Reception)

This week in Reception, we have been learning to read the sounds igh, oa and oo and the tricky words 'are' and 'her'.

In maths, we have been revising areas we have learnt this term, practising our subitising skills and ordering and comparing numbers. We have also begun to think about the seasons and how we change what we wear depending on the weather.

Most of our time this week has been dedicated to our rehearsals and performances of Whoops-A-Daisy Angel. The children have worked so hard, and we are really pleased with how they performed. Well done Reception!

Birch and Cherry (Year 1)

We are so proud of Year 1 this week for their fantastic performance of their songs. Thank you for all the lovely costumes and we hope you enjoyed the show as much as we did!

In English, we have enjoyed using story sack props to learn and retell the story of 'Handa's Surprise'. There are lots of adjectives describing the fruit in the story, so we focussed on identifying adjectives and using them in our own writing. We learnt how to spell 'like' and 'because' to write about our favourite fruits. Can your child identify the adjectives in the following sentence? I like strawberries because they are red, sweet and juicy.

In maths, we had a revision week to consolidate number recognition, counting, ordering and comparing. The children used their number knowledge to answer more and less questions and had a reminder of how to use the symbols:

> greater than, < less than, = equal to.

Our science investigation this week involved cuddly toys and watering cans! We had a selection of materials and tested how waterproof they were by holding them over the cuddly toy and pouring water to simulate rain. Some of the toys got very wet, but others remained dry. See if your child can remember the materials that were 'waterproof' and the ones that were 'absorbent'.

We have now finished learning the phase 3 phonemes. Our final sounds this week were: ear, air, ure, er. These are some of the hardest to remember how to read and write, so do please try and practise them at home. See if your child can read these words and can they spot the 'plural'? spear, chairs, mixture, hammer.

Hazel and Rowan (Year 2)

Year 2 have had yet another busy but exciting week. In English, we have started our new topic on the story 'The Snow Queen'. The children have completed some comprehension activities and showed us how well they have really understood this complicated story. Their predictions and discussions of the book were fantastic and they really impressed us with their ideas. They have also sequenced the story and been retelling the key events in their own words, why not ask your child to tell you the story of the Snow Queen?

In maths, we have completed end of term assessments to see how much learning the children have retained this term. We were blown away by their effort and they have shown us just how far their learning has come since they have been in Year 2. We have also continued our topic on shape by learning about the properties of 3D shapes. Ask your child - what is the difference between a face and an edge?

In DT, we have evaluated our final textile pieces. We considered what went well and what we would improve next time if we had the chance. We also considered how well our products fulfilled the design brief. We are very proud of what we have produced and can't wait to share them with you.

Finally, as you are probably aware, it has been performance week! It was wonderful to see so many of your smiling faces in the audience throughout the week. We are so proud of every single one of the children, they sang beautifully and spoke clearly, just like we practised. Thank you again for your help in practising lines at home and providing such wonderful costumes - the children looked fab!
