
The design brief

Using **one side** of an *unwanted* pillowcase (that's important before you start customising someone's favourite Egyptian pillowcase) design and create your artwork. Please have your pillowcase portrait (long side up). You can use paint to create your design or if you prefer it could be a textile creation, or try sewing other things on and mixing things up. When you've finished, bring it to the Corn Exchange by **Friday 28 April 2023** and we will turn the panels into our giant bunting ready for displaying.



Important information

We will be hanging our giant bunting outside, so whatever you create, it needs to stand up to the weather. Use a waterproof medium (acrylic paints are perfect) and anything that you stitch on or attach needs to be weatherproof and attached securely so that it will survive any wind and rain that may come our way.



What do I need?

1 x Pillowcase – any colour you like
Art/craft materials – Acrylic paints - Dash of imagination!



What do I do?

Create your own royal themed design in any medium you like on one side only... make sure that the pillowcase is portrait, so that the designs can all hang the same way.



Design tip!

Your artwork will be viewed from a distance so think about making your overall picture strong and dynamic. A tiny design and subtle details might look amazing close up but will be hard to see when it's hanging up high. And don't be afraid to fill the whole space!
