### **Little Acorns Class**

This week in Little Acorns Class, the children have been learning all about Autumn.

They have really enjoyed going on our Autumn walk to look at all the changes around us and they have loved the woodland roleplay area where they can look after the woodland animals and find them a safe home.

We have been reading the story 'Foggy Foggy Forest' and the children have been busy learning our song 'Autumn Leaves.' We have also started to learn our Christmas songs ready for our Nativity play in December.

The children have had lots of fun colour mixing, painting and printing using lots of Autumn colours it's been very messy!

Outside in the garden the children have been busy making leaf wands and collecting and looking at all the Autumn changes in our own garden.

#### **Acorns Class**

This week in Acorns Class, we have been reading the story of 'Foggy Foggy Forest.' We had to look at the pictures and try and guess who or what it was. We talked about how a shadow is made and modelled shadow making on our white board and drew around our hands.

We had a dark tent in the role play and had lots of torches to make shadow puppets and retell a story. We knew to turn off the torches after we had finished to save the battery.

In the garden we had dinosaurs in the tough tray and we drew round their shadows.

In outdoor learning we went on a number hunt to find different amounts of sticks/stones/leaves.

## Maple and Beech News (Reception)

In phonics this week, we had a recap week. We focused on all the phase 3 sounds we have learned so far, blending them into words and the tricky words we have learned so far. We have put a tricky word word-search on seesaw to have a go at (we haven't learned all of these yet).

In maths, we have been focusing in detail on the numbers 9 and 10 and thinking about the smaller numbers that go together to make them.

We have been learning about being safe on the roads. We looked at which of our coats would help us be seen in the dark and designed coats using different materials, picking the materials that would be the most reflective.

Our rehearsals are going full steam ahead ready for our Christmas performance. Very exciting!

## **Birch and Cherry (Year 1)**

In maths this week, we have been learning about capacity and volume. We have been using the vocabulary full, nearly full, nearly empty and empty. We have filled lots of different containers to see which one can hold the most.

In English, we have been continuing to write our non-fiction reports about Neil Armstrong and remembering to use spaces between words, capital letters and full stops. We have been working hard to rehearse our sentences out loud before we write. The children are doing amazingly well!

In Science, we have been looking at a range of different materials and have been using scientific vocabulary such as soft, smooth, rough and transparent to describe them. Can you look around your house and describe the different materials you can see?

We have also been practising hard for our Christmas performance and whenever there is a spare moment, we are dancing and singing!

## **Hazel and Rowan (Year 2)**

We've had a great TIME;) in year 2 this week!

In maths we have been recapping and learning about time! We have recapped our learning from Year 1 on, O'clock and Half past and now we have ventured into looking at quarter past and quarter to and how these times are represented by the hands on a clock face. Ask your child what time it is when the minute hand is at the 3 or 9! Year 2 have really impressed us with how much they already know about time and how well some of us can tell the time already.

Meanwhile in English, we have been planning and writing up our own winter setting descriptions. We have been using some amazing adjectives to describe things we might see, smell, hear, taste and touch in winter. The children have had some super ideas and we've been feeling extra hungry in our English lessons looking at pictures of gingerbread cookies to help prompt some discussions.

In history, we have been learning even more about the history of our school and Horatio Bland. We have started to collate all the facts we know about him to create a fact file. We extend our thanks to Mrs Harlow, our own school historian, who has taken so many steps to help us find out all about our school history.

In yoga this week, our focus has been on growth mindset. We have been learning some growth mindset phrases that help our superhero brains get stronger. Some of these phrases are - 'I can't do it YET' and 'I am strong'. These are phrases we can use when our lizard brain might be starting to take over and make us feel panicked.



The children are have been coming up with ideas for crafts and activities that they would like to do for the run up to Christmas! We have so far decided that we will be making mince pies and decorations for all our Bumblebees to take home.

We have also been given the task of designing a snowman for the Englefield snowman trail. All entries will be considered, and we will then commission one design for the final snowman!
