Ticket 2: £5

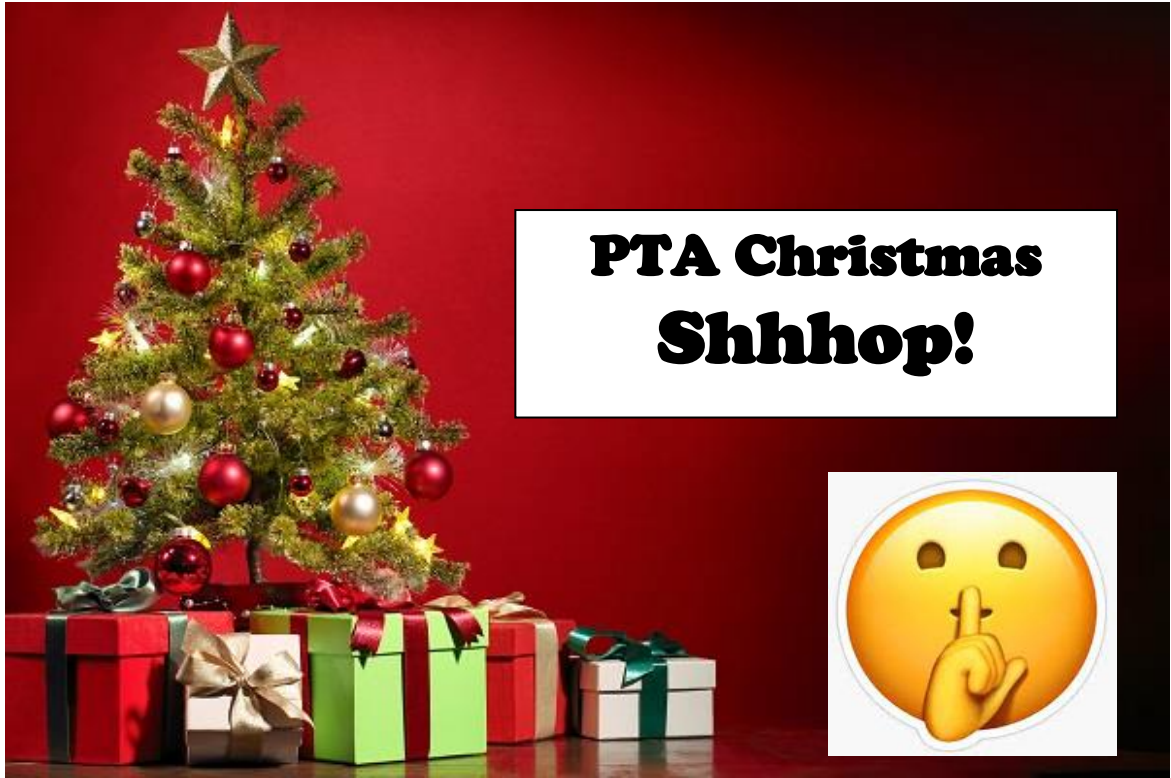
