This week in Little Acorns the children have been learning our numbers and looking at different foods making cakes with playdough and cutting fruits on our fine motor table.

We have been reading the story "The Little Red Hen" along with learning our nursery rhymes and number songs.

We have also started to learn our songs for our Christmas production which will take place on the Monday morning of the 11th December.

The children have been making the decorations ready to go on our tree that has been designed and made by the Acorns and Little Acorns children this will be displayed at the Christmas Tree Festival at St Marys church Burghfield on the 9th - 10th December please go down to admire our tree!

Outside in the garden the children have really loved exploring the garden to find different Autumn items on their treasure hunt list.

Acorns Class



This week in Acorns Class, we have read the story of 'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson. The children enjoyed naming all the different characters and loved playing in our Gruffalo Cave in the role play area.

In Maths we have been weighing items and deciding if they are 'heavier' or 'lighter'. The children enjoyed using the balance scales to test this.

We have decorated our nursery so it is full of sparkle! The children have been busy decorating fir cones for our Christmas Tree which will be displayed at the Christmas Tree Festival at St Marys church Burghfield on the 9th - 10th December please go down to have a look!

Our nursery Nativity is starting to take shape and we have been practising lots and lots. The performance will be held on Monday 11th December at 9.30am.

Maple and Beech News (Reception)



This week in phonics we have learnt the new digraphs th, ng, ai, ee and the tricky words they and all. Maybe you could play one of the phonics play games online www.phonicsplay.co.uk (resources – phase 3).

In Literacy, we have read the Nativity story and we have been retelling the story through small world, puppets and Role play. As well as sequencing pictures in our books.

In Maths we have been working with numbers to 10, singing 10 in the bed, comparing amounts saying which is more or less and practising formation of numerals.

We have also had our first whole school nativity practises. If you cannot provide the required costumes please let school staff know.

Birch and Cherry (Year 1)



This week the children have been learning about the incredible Mae Jamison, a dancer, engineer, doctor, actor and astronaut. She was the first black woman to go into space.

We have also been learning about how to weigh things in school, it would be wonderful if they could be involved in some cooking at home so that they can practice weighing thing accurately!

In yoga we practiced using our superhero brain during games, and learned how to respond to our friends when we don't win in a game.

We have of course been rehearsing for our performance and our singing is coming along beautifully for our play!



Another great week here in Year 2!

In Maths we have learnt all about money. We started the week by looking at coins and the value of all the different British coins. We noticed that they are all different shapes, sizes and colours! We then moved onto looking at the value of different notes, these were easier to identify as they say the value on them! Once we had familiarised ourselves with the value of all the different coins and notes we were then able to add up different amounts and compare values. To add up an amount of money we learnt it was easier to start with the coins/notes that had the biggest value.

In English, we have finished off writing our setting descriptions all about winter and have learnt how to do some editing of our own work! This was a great way of being able to read over our final piece as well as correct and improve any areas of it. We then ended the week with a really exciting writing activity to start off the December month... we had the choice to write letters to parents or Father Christmas! SO, watch out parents/carers for our letters that will be coming home telling you all about how naughty or nice we've been in Year 2 this year!


In the afternoons we have also been feeling extra festive because we have started whole school practices for our Christmas performance! We've also been making the school look more festive by creating some Christmas decorations.

Year 2 loved the calming exercise this week called 'expanding ball' to help calm our lizard brain and for our super hero brains to take control again. Ask your child to teach you the expanding ball breathing to see if they can remember it.
