23rd July 2024, 11 .00am - 2.00pm

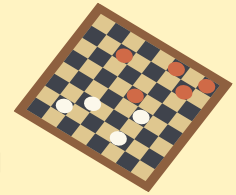

3rd August 2024, 11 .00am - 2.00pm

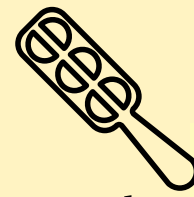
We're creating our own Olympics! Come along to find out where it all started! Indoor and outdoor games for all.
